Academy Seeking Red Cross First Aid/CPR Instructors

Injuries from sports participation are a significant cause of hospitalization and health care costs in youth. Sports injuries are the second leading cause of emergency room visits for youth and the second leading cause of injury in schools. One of the Metro Boston Coaches Academy's goals is to create a safer sports experience for the estimated 95,000 children between the ages of 5 and 18 in the metro Boston area. As an Academy First Aid/CPR Instructor, you will play a critical role in ensuring that these coaches have the tools, resources and support they need to create safe sport environments and provide quality care to those injured during practice or competition.

We are seeking individuals committed to improving the sports experiences of metro Boston youth through a network of quality-trained youth sport coaches. This is a paid independent contractor position. The ideal candidate should have at least 3 years experience as an athletic trainer or a Red Cross certified instructor, and have experience providing training, or teaching. Energetic presentation and communication skills are a must.

Responsibilities will include:

- Delivering a minimum of 2 Red Cross First Aid/CPR courses per year.
- Keeping your Red Cross Instructor Certification
- Representing the Metro Boston Coaches Academy Mission to our clients.
- Maintaining Metro Boston Coaches Academy standards.
